Basic Supplies Required For Camp-Please have at first lesson:

Straight pins and cushion or box

Measuring tape

Sharp scissors for fabric and threads

Paper cutting scissors

Pencil and notebook

Fabric marking pen

Hand sewing needle

Baby Lock machine bobbin (if your child will be using our sewing machines)

Tote bag or basket

Seam Gauge

Seam Ripper

- ❖ While we strive for every participant to finish their project(s), sometimes that does not happen. Classes are carefully designed to try and meet every participants' skill and comprehension level. Should you feel your child needs extra time or attention, please discuss your concerns with the instructor. We do offer private lessons for one on one instruction.
- ❖ Our staff will do everything possible to help students succeed. However, if we find your child unable to keep up with the rest of class or if we find your child unable to follow direction within reason, we reserve the right to remove your child from camp. You will be informed at the end of that days' session. Our experience has been that if a child is not ready for sewing camp, the instructor will know by the second day. Class fees will be refunded or credited towards private lessons. Supply costs will not be refunded.
- ❖ Please be on time. We have lots to cover and wouldn't want your child to miss any instruction time. Please make arrangements to arrive 10-15 minutes prior to class to allow time for setting up and getting prepared. Pick up time should be within 15 minutes of the scheduled end time.
- ❖ Ragtime Fabrics, LLC, cannot administer any medication.

- ❖ In the extremely rare event of an emergency, store personnel will evaluate the severity of the situation. Our first call will be to the name and number listed on the release/ permission form unless a professional emergency responders must be called first.
- ❖ While we love meeting family and friends, only registered students may be in the classroom.
- ❖ Cellphone use is STRICTLY prohibited from the classroom.
- ❖ Supply lists are given with the assumption your child will be making the project as specified. Should you wish to alter the project (with instructor approval) such as but not limited to changing lengths, sizes or design, supply requirement changes are the responsibility of the parent/ student.
- ❖ Students should dress appropriately. Please have long hair secured away from the face and dangly jewelry is discouraged. Shoes are required and must be worn during camp/ class, flip flops are discouraged.
- ❖ We cannot issue refunds for missed camp days. We do offer private lessons for one on one instruction.
- ❖ Ragtime Fabrics does not follow any weather related school closing guidelines. Call the store if you are unsure of a weather related closure.
